High School Student Application

Eligibility Requirements

1. Be a student who is a resident of Delaware County **OR**
2. Be a graduating senior **OR** a graduate in the Delaware County, New York School District
3. Intend to pursue a course leading to a Bachelor's, Associate's, Master's or Doctoral Degree in education, the physical sciences, engineering, or other related technical fields.

Selection Process

The Scholarship Committee will consider these criteria in making their selection:

1. Scholastic achievement, particularly in the chosen field of study, evidencing the ability to complete the applicant's course of study and educational goals.
2. Participation in extracurricular activities.
3. Good character and maturity, reflecting lifetime skills such as teamwork, responsibility, enthusiasm, independence, respect, honesty, integrity, and industriousness.
4. Financial need.

Deadline to Apply

Applications must be postmarked or hand delivered by Tuesday, April 15th, 2025. Applications received or postmarked after April 15th, 2025, will not be considered. Please complete the application in every detail required. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

Application Requirements

To be considered: Submit these required documents to the Scholarship Committee (postmarked or hand delivered) by Tuesday, April 15th, 2025.

- Completed application with photo.
- Type-written statement of educational goals, career objectives, and financial need. (not to exceed 500 words)
- Two (2) currently dated personal letters of recommendation indicating which scholarship is being applied for. Letters must be from non-related persons, preferably, high school sources and on school letterhead. These may be emailed to trust@dnbd.net
- Official** (sealed by Registrar) transcript from your high school.

If you are a Delaware County resident who IS NOT graduating from a Delaware County school, please check that your official high school transcript includes your physical address (not a PO Box) so we may obtain verification of residency from the Delaware County Treasurer's Office.

If your transcript only lists a PO Box, please provide one of the following:

- Copy of driver's license or passport showing the physical address.**
- Copy of a tax bill showing the physical address.**
- Copy of a utility bill showing the physical address, dated more than 1 year prior to the submission of this application**
